November 13, 2018	Accepting Applications for Paramedics, AEMT and EMT's
January 8, 2019	Closing Application
Application document review: Each applicant will receive a notification if they meet the criteria to take the on-line exam with a link attachment.	
January 18-20, 2019	Online written exam process: This exam is timed and each question is randomized. Once you start your exam you must commit to the exam, the timer cannot be stopped. Applicants will receive a link for on-exam along with DROPBOX notice to upload a photo/headshot of themselves, 01/20/2019 deadline
January 22, 2019	A email notification will be sent to applicants for their next phase (Practical Exams) of hiring process by end of business day
January 30-31 & February 1 2019	Practicals' Stations: EMT's, AEMT & Paramedics Note: You will be schedule for an 1-hour session on one of these two days
February 3, 2019	Physical Agility Testing – Email notice with a set time will be sent by the end of the day on 2/1/2019. Allow for 2-hours Passing candidates will be scheduled for an interview at the end of Physical Agility.
February 4, 5, 6, 2019	Interviews, each applicant will take 30 minutes; you will only be scheduled one session on one of these days (Note: Out-of-Town applicants will be given the opportunity to be first to interview.)
February 11, 2019	A decision letter will be sent to your email Please do not call the office for your result or schedule. Please check your email

Note: If offered a full time position, the New Hire Academy will start on March 11, 2019 (Four-Week Academy)
